You are invited to apply for a pitch at this event which last year attracted over 6000 paying visitors.

The Clun Green Man Festival May Fair of Country Crafts is now a well known annual event held on the Castle site at Clun (courtesy of English Heritage) the first bank holiday Monday in May. This event celebrates the arrival of the first signs of Summer and uses many traditional forms and symbols. It skilfully combines drama, music and colour to provide an unforgettable day for all. The event is well advertised throughout the Midlands area.

The Green Man heads a procession from Clun's Parish Church at noon, leading a vast array of people - musicians, jugglers and entertainers - around the town and arrives at about half past noon on the castle site, where he declares the May Fair open. The public are not admitted on to the castle grounds before 12 noon. Stallholders will be admitted from 8.30 am. The fair closes at 4.30 pm.

Under English Heritage rules only cars and light vans up to 7m in length are permitted to drive down the grass ramps into the castle precincts. In order to reduce damage to the site, this year we are offering pitches with parking space behind for a car or van. We are asking you to indicate in your application the size of your vehicle. For pitches without room for a vehicle, off-site parking will be provided.

Stallholders are encouraged to bring their own gazebos and decorate them with their wares to create the atmosphere of a medieval market place. If you wish to dress appropriately, please do so. We do not supply any tables or weather protection, so bring your own.

The organisers are inviting applications to trade from genuine crafts people with high quality products to sell. Last year, we had to turn many traders down as the event was oversubscribed, therefore you are advised to send in your application early.

Applicants will be allotted the same stall(s) as 2010 as far as possible up to 30th August after which time all stalls remaining will be allotted on a first come first served basis. The intention of the fair is to promote/demonstrate traditional crafts, and we particularly wish to encourage local craftspeople and traders. Please give as much information as possible about your products or activities, so that we can ensure a well balanced selection of stalls. Publicity material will be welcomed.
