## Monday 2nd May

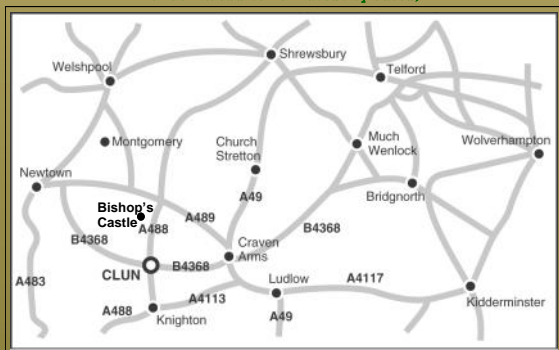
12 noon: the Green Man enters Clun accompanied by
